For 30 minutes on Monday through Thursday mornings the student body gathered to experience a "virtual mission trip" to Paraguay. This was sponsored by Lutheran Hour Ministries and was a live video streaming from their headquarters in St. Louis with a connection to a ministry director in Paraguay.
