CHAPEL OFFERING UPDATE

December 2012

As previously reported, the first quarter chapel offerings were designated to help support a semi-nary student who made a presentation to Silo students last March during National Lutheran Schools Week. The month of November is designated in support of the Food Shelf and the Mitten Tree.

The balance of the second quarter, December and January, is designated for Lutheran Association of Missionary Pilots (LAMP). This is a group of pilot pastors who "fly" the Gospel to Native American communities in Canada. These are communities that are accessible only by air.

As a subset of that, teams of volunteers associate themselves with LAMP and fund themselves to go into a one of these communities and teach VBS for a week in the summer. Our offerings will help to fund one of these teams. In conversation with the team leader, we have been promised that they will provide us with personalized information as well as an on-site visit next spring.

FAMILIES HAVE ONLINE ACCESS TO GRADES
