NOVEMBER FOOD DRIVE & MITTEN TREE

The resource center is able to get commodity foods without a problem. The things that they can always use are canned fruit, sugar, flour, toilet tissue, jell-o or pudding, dry cereal (hot or cold), cream soups, cake mixes, and mixed vegetable. Cash donations are also accepted and will be used solely to buy items for the food shelf. The food shelf buys items from channel one at the government price of 18 cents a pound.
