CRYSTAL TEWS GIVES REPORT TO STUDENTS

During the first quarter of the school year the students have been collecting offerings during chapel services in support of Crystal Tews' Mercy Medical Team trip to Madagascar. As a part of this team she was representing the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod and Immanuel Lutheran Church and School.

Crystal was in chapel on October 26 to share her experiences with the student body and about 25 guests. She shared slides, short videos, and some souvenirs.

With one chapel service left in the first quarter the total gathered to date is slightly over \$570. This money will help Crystal to offset her personal expenses and to help pay for supplies that her team took along.

Crystal addressed a note of appreciation to Immanuel Lutheran Church and School.

I want to send a special thank you to each of you (and your families!) for supporting me through your chapel offerings these past couple of months. Thank you also for keeping me in your prayers while I was traveling to and from Madagascar with Mercy Medical Team. I have been looking forward to talking with all of you about the trip! The second quarter chapel offerings will be designated for helping Martin Luther School in Joplin, MO. Martin Luther was one of the buildings in Joplin that was damaged but not destroyed in the tornado last May. I will share more information about the challenges and opportunities that Martin Luther School faces as a result of the tornado.
