SCHOOL ENROLLMENT **October 2011**

The opening day enrollment for Kindergarten through grade eight was 91 students. The preschool enrollment adds another 14 students to that number, for a total student population of 105. The following paragraphs will break down these numbers in a variety of ways, and compare them to the same numbers from the aggregate of all LCMS schools for the 2010-2011 (the most recent statistics available at this time) school year. Those comparative figures will be shown in parenthesis () after our local numbers.

63% (39%) belong to Immanuel - the owner-operator congregation. 1% (5%) hold church membership in another LCMS congregation. 3% (3%) are members of a Lutheran church affiliated with a synod other than LCMS. 33% (36%) hold church membership in a church that is non-Lutheran. The numbers for Silo School add up to 100%, but not those for the rest of the schools across our church body. The reason for this is that nation-wide our schools enroll 17% of the student body who do not belong to any church.

If there is such a thing as an "average" school, for our school system that school would have eight full-time teachers with 110 students. We compare to that with 5.6 full-time teachers (this includes a part-time principal) and 91 students.

CHAPEL OFFERINGS

This year four recipients have been chosen for our students to support through weekly chapel offerings. The first quarter's offerings are being donated in support of Crystal Tews (Mrs. Anderson's sister) to help defray personal costs on her medical mission trip to Madagascar. We look forward to hearing a report from her when she returns.

The second quarter offerings will be sent to our Lutheran school in Joplin, MO which was damaged, but not destroyed, in the tornado last May. Martin Luther School was able to serve as a community gathering place following the tornado.

During the third quarter we will join the other Lutheran schools of the Minnesota South District in support of the work done by Orphan Grain Train headquar-

tered in Norfolk, NE.

Fourth quarter offerings

become very personal again. These offerings will be donated to a nephew of Miss Meinert who is patiently waiting for a heart and kidney transplant. As you can imagine, these bills become monumental.

An add-on project will be to collect food for the Food Shelf during National Lutheran Schools Week in March.
