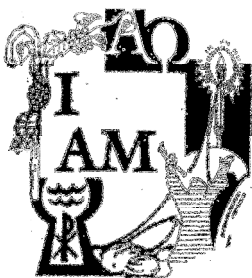
That same day will be the congregational hayride and picnic at the Arches Farmers' Park following the late church service.

ADMINISTRATIVE SOFTWARE INSTALLED

The Board of Education has approved the use of a web-based software that will serve the school very well as a record-keeping tool for all student and family data. This software has many facets about it. Included on this software is an electronic grade book and the ability to keep attendance electronically. The beauty of this program is that it will be accessible to teachers from any computer that has a connection to the internet.

Considerable time and effort has already, and will continue to be, invested into getting this program set up and customized for our school. It's an investment that will pay dividends well into the future.

Another long term benefit of this program will eventually be that parents will be able to log into the web site and check their child's academic progress. The teachers need to be given time to learn how to use the software and become comfortable with it before that option will become available.

The only change will be the organization and grouping of the information.
